

## Christmas card 1:

### You will need:

A4 card

Green paper/card to cut up

Scissors

Glue

Yellow or gold paper or pens for a star

Brown paper or pen for the tree stump



1. Fold A4 card in half
2. Cut green (or another colour if you're changing the colour of the tree) into strips
3. Make sure strips are all different lengths
4. Stick brown stop of paper at the bottom of the front of the card
5. Glue down strips of green paper - overlapping in different diagonal directions with small or no gaps
6. Finish off the tree with a star or angel at the top
7. Decorate the tree with pictures of baubles, tinsel etc.

Christmas card 2:

**You will need:**

A4 card

All different coloured paper/card to cut up

Scissors

Glue

Yellow or gold paper or pens for a star

Brown paper or pen for the tree stump



1. Fold A4 card in half
2. Cut all different colours of paper (or colour on your own white paper) into thin strips
3. Criss-cross your strips of paper and stick them down
4. Make sure the pieces of paper get shorter as you go up the tree, so that it makes a triangle shape
5. Do you want to add any baubles, tinsel, lights, a star, an angel or a tree stump?

## Christmas tags

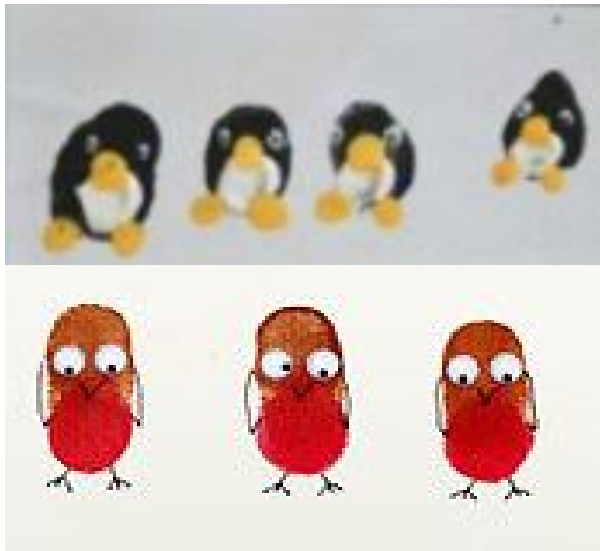
### You will need:

Paints

Pens

Thick paper or card

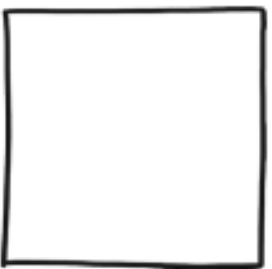
String, ribbon or tape



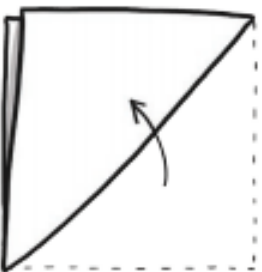
1. Fold an A4 paper or card in half, half again, half again and half again.
2. Open up the paper/card and cut along the fold lines - now you have your tags to decorate.
3. Dip just the tip of your fingers into paint - brown for reindeer, white and black for penguins or all different colours for baubles or lights. Let your paint dry - this is important!
4. Get a thin black pen to add outlines and details to your finger tip prints - join them up with swirls for lights, add faces for penguins and add antlers for reindeer.
5. Use a hole punch or a pen/pencil to poke a hole into one end of the tag.
6. Thread string through the hole and tie a knot to put the ends together.

# Paper Snowflake Craft

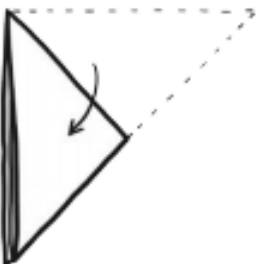
1 Start with a square piece of paper.



2 Fold the paper in half to make a triangle.



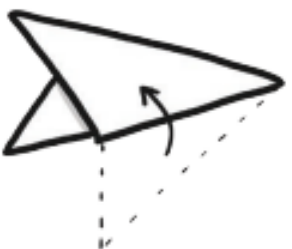
3 Fold the paper in half again.



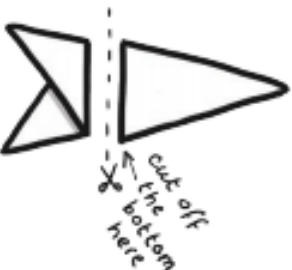
4 Make a fold a third of the way across the triangle.



5 Fold the other side over to create an arrowhead shape.



6 Cut off the bottom to make a triangle.



7 Make additional cuts like the ones below.



8 Unfold to reveal your snowflake!



Christmas calendar:

**You will need:**

A4 card - any colour

1 calendar tab

Glue

Scissors

1 split pin

Colouring pencils / felt tips

Something round to cut around - a roll of cellotape / tin / jar



1. Draw around and cut out 2 circles
2. Split 1 circle into 4 quarters with a pen/pencil
3. Decorate the 4 quarters differently to show the 4 seasons - Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter - trees, clothes, animals etc.
4. Decorate the second circle or leave it blank.
5. Stick the decorated circle to the A4 card.
6. Push a split pin through the middle of the other circle and attach it, only by the pin, on top of the seasons circle.
7. Cut out a window or a quarter of the top circle so that you can see the season pictures below, when you turn it.
8. Stick on your calendar tab.
