The MFL Curriculum:


- Helps to equip pupils with the knowledge and cultural understanding needed to succeed at life

Teach clear building blocks of languages for children to develop their understanding of reading and conversing in Spanish, such as sounds, words and rules around phonics, vocabulary and grammar
